



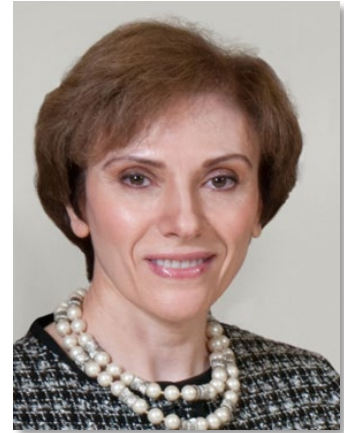

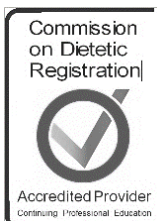

The seminar will cover systematic mechanistic and neuropathological studies that led to the identification of a new therapeutic target for neuroprotection in several neurodegenerative diseases. These learnings formed the basis for identifying a compound in coffee that has protective activity as monotherapy and functions synergistically with caffeine.
