Nutritional Regulation of Muscle Growth in Neonates

Nutrition during early postnatal period is a critical factor that impacts the growth and survival of infants. The lecture will focus on the nutritional regulation of muscle growth and the role of amino acids and insulin in regulating the synthesis of skeletal muscle proteins in neonates. Recent studies demonstrating that prematurity limits the anabolic response to feeding will be discussed.
