Despite the highly successful implementation of GLP-1 receptor agonists into the clinic for the treatment of patients with type 2 diabetes, these therapeutics do not recapitulate the physiological patterns of endogenous GLP-1 secretion. These rhythms and their molecular underpinnings will be described, and potential implications for future clinical approaches will be discussed.
